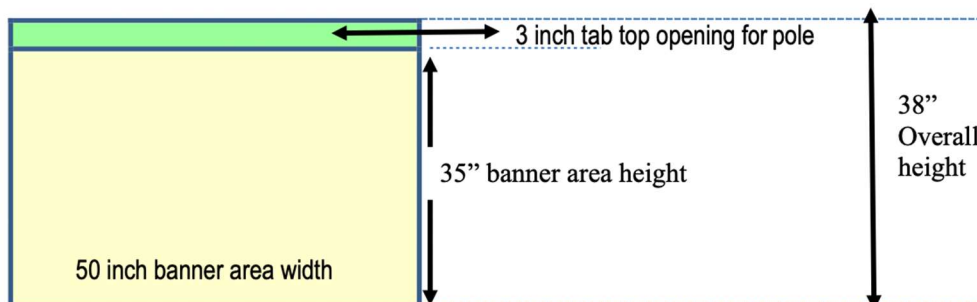


Banners:

1. CLASSES:
 - a. There are two classes offered: A) Themed and B) Open.
 - b. Themed banners shall use the following theme for 2021: To Be Announced
 - c. Open banners may feature any theme promoting 4-H or FFA. Make sure when you look at the banner, that you can tell what it represents.
2. SIZE AND CONSTRUCTION:
 - a. Banner dimensions must be 50" wide and 38" tall. Failure to comply with dimensions will cause the banner to be disqualified and not receive a premium.
 - b. Banner must be constructed to hang on a pole. The opening for the pole should be a minimum of 3", and is included in the overall size of 38" long.
 - c. Banners may be constructed of any type of durable material. Must be able to be folded or rolled.
 - d. Appliqué and embroidery are suggested applications. The design must be on one side only.
3. Banner MUST Display:
 - a. Banner Title
 - b. Minimum of one OFFICIAL 4-H Clover or FFA crest must be displayed with a minimum height or width of 6 inches.
4. ID CARD:
 - a. Identification card must be typed not handwritten. Font size minimum 16pt.
 - b. Card should be (business card size) 2"x3.5" in size and displayed horizontally.
 - c. Securely attached with safety pins, sewn, or glued on the back side of the banner on a bottom corner.
 - d. The ID card must include the Club/Chapter Name and the county.
 - e. MISSING ID CARDS WILL RESULT IN SCORE DEDUCTION.
5. Banners will be judged as follows: Id Card attached, design, craftsmanship, durability, has clover and AA Statement, effective title (short, personal, an action verb), conveys a message (accomplishes a purpose), booth attracts attention, holds interest, general appearance, workmanship, correct dimensions, and has a suitable subject



The Club Scrapbook and Officer's Handbook will be judged on the club activities of the first six months of 2022.

Use a separate entry form for club entries so that premiums are sent to the appropriate club leader. A club may exhibit one booth in each of two classes.

One Champion and one Reserve Champion will be awarded for classes ZZ1 & ZZ2. One Champion and one Reserve Champion will be awarded from classes ZZ4. One Champion and one Reserve Champion will be awarded for classes ZZ6 and ZZ7.
