

1. Exhibitors may only enter 1 exhibit per class.
2. All exhibits must be clean and free of labels and tags, unless otherwise specified in the section or class.
3. A Champion and Reserve Champion will be selected from each age division (Junior, Intermediate, Senior).
4. "Original design" means not from a kit.
5. Judging Criteria: safety; age appropriateness; educational value.
6. Attach a 3" x 5" card to the exhibit indicating the age level the item is intended for the educational value of the item. Please print the card.

- ?A1 Toy – original design
- ?A2 Toy – made from a kit
- ?A3 Game (1) – include instruction for playing the game, game must fit on 12" deep shelf
- ?A4 Visual aid – create an item (picture book, puppet, etc.) to use when telling a story to a child, include a summary on how it will be used
- ?A5 Storybook – original design, must tell a story
- ?A6 Original Education book or skit, not a story
- ?A7 Stuffed animal or doll – original design
- ?A8 Child Care Kit – a bag of games, books & toys that may be taken to a babysitting job (minimum 10 items). Identify each item with age level and how it will be used.
- ?A9 Basic First Aid Kit – include a list of the contents
- ?A10 Babysitter's Scrapbook (1) – with pictures for specific age group
- ?A11 Babysitting Display – refer to listing in project book for suggested topics, display must be sturdy enough to stand alone and cannot exceed 32"W x 17"D x 42"H
- ?A12 Child Care/Babysitting Reference Book – a notebook that includes general and specific information on child care and babysitting; may include short magazine articles, activities you conducted as part of project work, of fact sheets.
